The Administration plans to be in Manu'a for the Manu'a flag day festivities. Events and festivities planned from July 14th-16th.

On July 16th, Governor Lemanu and Lt. Governor Talauega will lead a delegation to Ta'u, Manu'a, to celebrate Manu'a Cession Day.

Events leading up to the day of the official flag-raising ceremony will include a fishing tournament, farm fair, and island tours will begin on Wednesday, July 14th.

On Thursday, July 15th, youth groups from Ofu and Olosega will arrive in Ta'u. They will also be joining Ta'u youth groups for the arts council program that same evening.

The fishing tournament will conclude on Thursday with a prize-giving ceremony.

The Manua Cession Day Church Service will be Thursday afternoon at 2 pm, at the EFKAS Malamalama o le Lalolagi church, Ta'u, Manu'a, led by Reverend Elder Iosefa Autele, EFKAS, and followed by the "Usu o le Itumalo" shortly after.

On Friday, July 16th, the program will include a parade, flag-raising ceremony, and the Manu'a Itumalo traditions and customs.
