PROCLAMATION

“NATIONAL WIC BREASTFEEDING WEEK

August 1 – 7, 2024”

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Agriculture and cooperating State health departments, Territories, and Tribal organizations celebrate 50 years of the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children improving pregnancy outcomes and health and developmental outcomes of children; and

WHEREAS, in American Samoa, the Department of Human and Social Services (DHSS) is the lead agency administering the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC), which includes breastfeeding promotion and empowering WIC participants to meet their individual breastfeeding goals by providing tailored, evidence-based WIC food packages along with WIC Breastfeeding Support; and

WHEREAS, the American Samoa WIC (ASWIC) Program employs mothers who have breastfeeding experience as Breastfeeding Peer Counselors to offer breastfeeding education, support, and role modeling using the Breastfeeding Support evidence-based model as its framework; and

WHEREAS, breastfeeding remains the most natural way of feeding infants and serves as part of a foundation for lifelong health and wellness; and

WHEREAS, the American Academy of Pediatrics recommends exclusive breastfeeding so your infant can receive the full nutritional and non-nutritional benefits that breastmilk provides for their growth and development; and

WHEREAS, infants receiving human milk are protected against serious long-term health conditions including obesity, respiratory and ear infections, asthma, allergies, diarrhea, childhood cancer, sudden infant death syndrome, and less-than-optimal brain development; and

WHEREAS, breastfeeding promotes strong family bonds while providing economic and societal benefits through lowered healthcare costs; and

WHEREAS, a united effort is needed from businesses, communities, governmental leaders, and healthcare providers to support breastfeeding; and

WHEREAS, the DHSS American Samoa Women, Infants, and Children's (ASWIC) Program will promote the 2024 World Breastfeeding Week theme of "CLOSING THE GAP: BREASTFEEDING SUPPORT FOR ALL!" Breastfeeding significantly improves the survival, health, and well-being of infants, children, and mothers. Together, we all need to emphasize the importance of supporting breastfeeding for everyone, especially during times of emergencies and crises; and

WHEREAS, government and businesses are encouraged to ensure that working mothers have an appropriate place and reasonable break times to express breast milk for their nursing child. Also, communities can support existing laws that protect a mother's right to breastfeed her child in any public location.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEMANU P. S. MAUGA, Governor of the Territory of American Samoa, do hereby proclaim the week of August 1st – 7th, 2024 as "WIC BREASTFEEDING WEEK", as promoted by ASWIC in American Samoa. I call upon all government, business leaders, and health professionals to celebrate with appropriate events and activities to acknowledge with gratitude the efforts of breastfeeding mothers, as well as fathers and everyone else who supports, encourages, and assist mothers to succeed in breastfeeding.
